

Three Types of Lesson Plans



In this Tip Sheet: You will learn about three different types of lesson plans found in the NCCIE Teaching Resource Centre

- There are over 80 lesson plans on NCCIE.CA. Most lesson plans are based on an [NCCIE template](#) that has an Indigenous lens and was created with guidance from Elders.
- After clicking on a lesson plan in a 'Results' list (see Tip Sheet #3), you will be taken to a webpage that contains the lesson you have selected.
- Depending on the lesson plan you have selected, you will see the information displayed in one of three ways:
 - *One type of display is a lesson plan for teaching a **mainstream subject**, such as math, science, art, music, etc.*
 - *Another type of display is a lesson plan for teaching an **Indigenous language**.*
 - *A third display contains a pre-existing lesson plan that has been uploaded as a whole document for you to access. In these instances, lesson plans have been shared with NCCIE for your use.*
- All lesson plan webpages provide you with the resources you need (e.g., videos, links, readings, etc.) to be able to deliver the lesson.
 - *Additional links and relevant background information are included for you to familiarize yourself with the material.*
 - *You can also search for more information in the NCCIE [Resource Library](#), the [Teaching Resources](#) collection, or on the world wide web.*
- You are encouraged to read the '[Read First](#)' document, which provides you with foundational information regarding:
 - *How lesson plans on the website are not 'one-size-fits-all;'*
 - *How you are encouraged to connect with First Nations, Métis, or Inuit communities where you live to learn about the diversity of cultures and Peoples near you;*
 - *How the 'Acknowledgement Protocol' is a key part of each lesson for you to read out loud and discuss with the class;*
 - *How NCCIE does not promote the idea of 'Pan-Indigeneity' and what this means;*
 - *If you wish to adapt a lesson to where you live;*
 - *And more.*
